  - committing an act(s) of bullying;
  - failing to comply with our reasonable rules and directions.
2. Every effort will be made to ensure the Junior Active Leader course is delivered with reasonable skill and care and in accordance with the practices and procedures of the Course Host.
3. Photography may be undertaken during the Junior Active Leader course for the purposes of recording performance, publicising the course in the future, or for other business purposes relating to our programmes. Photographs will only be taken of individuals whose consent has been provided on the Student Registration form.
4. We accept no liability for loss, damage, vandalism or theft of personal property of the participant including but not limited to jewelry, mobile phones, items of clothing or shoes regardless of how the loss occurred.
5. Participants are required to attend all of the relevant course sessions in order to gain the Junior Active Leader Award.
