




Greys Court loop

DIFFICULTY RATING: **EASY/MODERATE**. Woodland trails, field tracks but hilly in places.

Why not complete the 'Smartie challenge' as you make your way around this route?

ROUTE	MAP
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Park in the layby on Rocky Lane (Red arrow) & then take the path towards Greys Court.2. Follow the lane, keeping Greys Court on your left. When you reach the 'Ticket office', turn left through the car park & follow the footpath across the field towards the woodland.3. When you enter the woodland, take the path which branches left. Continue to follow across the first field; cross the lane & follow the footpath diagonally left across the next field into Famous Copse.4. As you enter the copse, keep to the left footpath. Follow this around the edge of the woodland.5. When you get to the edge of the woodland, take the left path out of the copse.6. Follow the footpath as it branches left and eventually runs parallel with Rocky Lane.7. Greys Court loop

The 'Smartie' challenge!

You need a tube of smarties with the same number of each colour smarties as you have children.

Prepare a piece of card for each child with a coloured dot on each representing the same colour as each of the smarties. Each child needs a small pencil. Parents keep the smarties.

The rule of the game is that you can only eat a smartie if you spot the smartie's colour on your walk. Then you cross it off. Parent administers smarties. Children can decide to work together or alone.
