






New Copse, Old Copse Loop

DIFFICULTY RATING: EASY/MODERATE. Reasonably flat route across farmer's fields, lanes & woodland trails.

On the next page are some animals you might see on this route. Did you spot any?

ROUTE

- 1. Start in the centre of the village & head towards Kennylands Road.
- 2. Turn left onto Kennylands Road, cross Grove Road & then take the footpath about 100m down on your right.
- 3. Go though the gate at the bottom of the path & head straight across the farmer's field.
- 4. Cross the stile & head straight across the second field.
- 5. Go through the kissing gate & turn right onto the track.
- 6. Follow the track; cross the road & continue to follow the lane in front of you (Chiltern Edge School to your right.)
- 7. Cross the second road (Horsepond Road) and continue to follow the lane until you reach the bend & entrance into New Copse on your right.
- 8. Enter New Copse and take the right-hand footpath. Head straight along this footpath until you reach the edge of the wood.
- 9. When you get to the edge of the wood, turn right & cross the road in front of you. (Horsepond Road.)
- 10. Take the path immediately in front of you into Old Copse. Keep to the path on your right & follow it round to the entrance on Woodlands Road.
- 11. Walk down Woodlands Road, turn right & you will find yourself back in the centre of the village.


