



## Spring Wood Colmore Lane Loop

DIFFICULTY RATING: MODERATE/HIGH: Woodland trails; fields and steep ascents/ descents in places.

## THE RAINBOW WALK

Answer the questions on the next page as you walk around this route. All answers are associated with colours. Match the letters to the question.

## ROUTE

- 1.Start in the centre of the village & walk down Wood Lane until you reach the Peppard Road.
- 2. Carefully cross the road & head up Widmore Lane.
- 3. When you get to the junction with Pond End Road, turn left. (QUESTION A)
- 4. Then turn right onto Churchill Crescent & left onto Blounts Court Road.
- 5. About 200m on the right (after the Tudor House) take the footpath across the field. (B)
- 6. Follow the path straight across the field & down the hill to the bottom of the wood. (C)
- 7. When you get to the bottom of the hill, take the path diagonally left across the field.
- 8. Go through the kissing gate and head up the wooded footpath.
- 9. When you reach the top, follow the lane left until you reach the road at the end. (D)
- 10. At the end of the road, turn left, walk for 150m & then cross the road in front of you.
- 11. Turn diagonally right & join the footpath heading left in front of you on the common. You should have the pub on your right-hand side. (E)
- 12. Keeping the pub on your right, follow the footpath straight until you get to the lane.
- 13. Cross the lane & then take the footpath into the wooded area directly in front of you.
- 14. Follow the footpath & it will lead you down a steep descent onto the bottom of Colliers Lane.
- 15. At the end of the footpath turn right into the woods. (F)
- 16. Stay on the main footpath through the woods & after about  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile you will come to a clearing. (G)
- 17. Continue to follow the footpath into the next woods. After another  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile, take the footpath which forks up to your left.
- 18. Follow the footpath until it reaches a junction with another path. Turn left & follow the footpath until it reaches the lane. (H)
- 19. Follow the lane for about  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile until you reach 'Rose Cottage' which will be directly in front of you. (I)
- 20. Continue to follow the lane until you reach the Unicorn pub. (J)

- 21. Turn right, cross the road & walk onto Wyfold Lane.22. Follow Wyfold Lane and then turn left onto Chiltern Road. (K)
- 23. Follow Chiltern Road to the very end. (L)
- 24. Cross the road in front of you & head onto Shiplake Bottom.
- 25. About 200m on your right, take the path which leads into Old Copse.
- 26. Follow the main path straight which will then bring you out onto Woodlands Road.
- 27. Walk straight down Woodlands Road until you get to the Hare & Hounds pub. (M)
- 28. Continue to follow Woodlands Road until you get to the end & then turn right back into the village centre.
