



Crowsley Peppard Church Loop

DIFFICULTY RATING: **MODERATE/HIGH** Variety of terrain and hilly in places.

ROUTE	ROUTE & MAP
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1.Head to the bottom of Wood Lane, turn right and continue walking until you reach the Millennium field.2.Go through the gate at the bottom left of the field opposite the Bird in Hand pub.3.Walk to the right of the pub and take the path to your left. Head straight towards horse's field.4. Pass through the kissing gate & head diagonally right across the horse's field.5. Go through the next gate & join & follow the path to your left.6. When you join the road, turn right and follow round to the end.7. When you get to the end of the road, turn left; walk 200m & then enter the gates on your right. (Dog head statues on top of pillars.)8. Follow the road for 400m & then enter 2 X sets of green gates to your right. You are now on Crowsley Park.9. Head diagonally right through the kissing gate & continue to follow the path. When you reach the main path, turn left & follow that path down the steep hill towards the mock Tudor house.10. Go through the kissing gate & turn left onto the road. Turn left & then take the first right turn. (Kings Farm Lane.)11. Follow this single-track road for about 1 mile until you reach the dilapidated 'White Cottage' on your left.12. Take the footpath on your left immediately after 'White Cottage.'13. Follow the forest path to the end where you will see a kissing gate.14. Go through the gate, head straight (across the golf course) until you reach the next kissing gate.	<p>5.36mi Peppard Road Kings Farm Lane</p> <p>Made with @footpathapp</p>

15. Go through the gate and follow the path to the end. Turn right.
16. Take the next footpath on your left (opposite Peppard Church).
17. Go through the kissing gate & take the path down the steep hill to your right.
18. At the bottom of the hill, head left towards the gate at the edge of the wood.
19. Go through the gate into the wood & follow the steep path upwards. (Elephant well on your right near the top.)
20. When you reach the field at the top, follow the path straight until you get to Blounts Court Road.
21. Turn left onto the road & then take the first right onto Churchill Crescent.
22. Then take first left & then first right where you will be on Widmore Lane.
23. Head straight back up into the village centre.
