




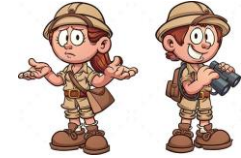
The 'Dinosaur' walk



DIFFICULTY RATING: HIGH A variety of terrain and hilly in places.

Why not complete the questions on the next page as you walk around the route?

ROUTE	MAP
<p>1. Starting at the Co-op, turn left down Woodlands Road and enter the Old Copse at the end. Take the middle of the three paths and continue walking straight on until you reach the road. On your right is an old well. (Questions A & B on reverse.)</p> <p>2. Carefully cross the road, then walk left for a few metres and turn right on the footpath through the gate. Keep on the trodden path which hugs the right hand side of the field. Continue on through the gate and then look right for a path. Take the path which passes a field on the right where horses often graze. At the end of the path turn right and walk up the road towards the Unicorn pub. Carefully cross the crossroads. (Question C)</p> <p>3. Turn left up Colmore Lane and continue walking all the way until you reach a blue painted house. Turn left down the path through the woods and then keep to the right hand path when it forks. Keep walking straight on at the crossroads with another path. (Question D)</p> <p>4. Turn left (opposite Holly Tree Cottage) and then take the right path to reach the crossroads. Carefully cross and go straight on up the road until you reach Wyfold Court Estate. Take the left path. (Question E)</p> <p>5. When you reach a road (Lime Avenue) go straight on. In spring time you will walk through a wonderful bed of garlic. At the end of the small woodland where the garlic grows, take the left path, continuing straight on. (Question F)</p> <p>6. When you reach the road (Wyfold Lane) turn left and walk up the hill continuing until you reach a red postbox in the wall. (Question G)</p> <p>7. Turn right down the next footpath on the right towards Gallowstree Common. Continue straight on until the footpath turns left. Turn left here through the woods. This is New Copse. Keep left (sometimes this is very muddy). Follow the left arrows. Take the right fork in the path and go straight on. Go left at the gate and then straight to the road. This is Horsepond Road. Walk straight on in between the new wood fence until you reach a football field on your right. Go through the gate onto the field and follow straight until it takes you back into the woods.

8. Take the path out onto the farmer's field; take the gate on your left and then follow lane back out onto Woodlands Road. Turn right and then head back down into the village centre.
