




Nettlebed: Short Route

DIFFICULTY RATING: **LOW:** Reasonably flat along pavements, tracks and woodland trails.

START POINT: Recreation Ground, Nettlebed, RG9 5AR - there is parking behind the pavilion accessed from the next turning after the Recreation Ground.

ROUTE	MAP
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. From the Recreation Ground, head back to the B481. Turn left, pass the Old Brick Kiln on your left and then at the 'T' junction, turn right onto the High Street. 2. Pass the primary school and the Field Kitchen on your left and then take the first footpath on your right. Follow this footpath until it meets the B481 again. Take the first left onto Bush's Lane. Look out for the white arrows on the trees. 3. Stay on the central track for about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile until you reach a crossroads of paths; turn right and follow into Copse Wood. Continue to follow until you again meet the B481. 4. Turn left briefly onto the B481 (there is a bank on the left so you can stay off the road). Cross with care and take the next footpath on your right. 5. Keep on the central footpath and this will take you through Nettlebed Common Wood. Keep following the white arrows. 6.
