



Nettlebed: Medium Route

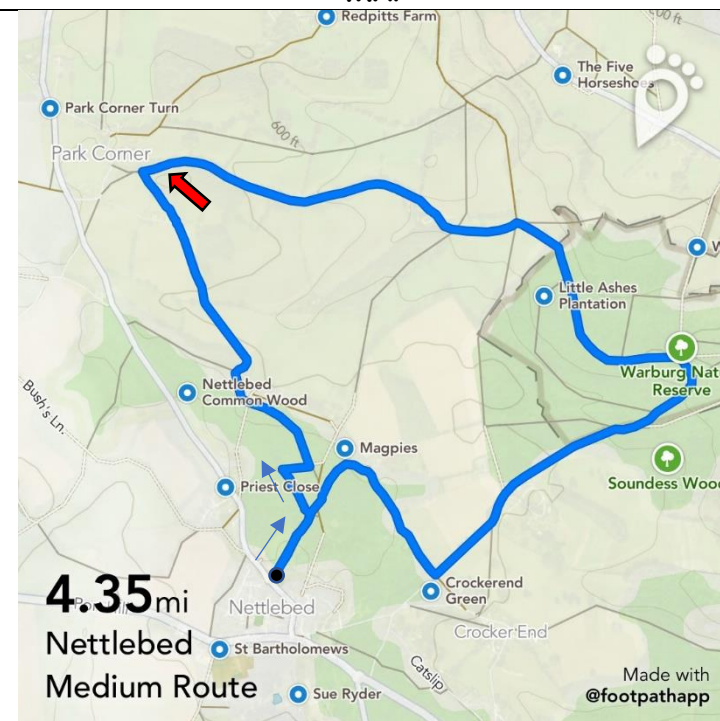
DIFFICULTY RATING: **MEDIUM/ HIGH:** A variety of terrain, a few steep climbs and muddy in places.

START POINT: Recreation Ground, Nettlebed, RG9 5AR

ROUTE

1. Head to the opposite side of the Recreation Ground and take the central footpath. At the first crossroads of paths, turn left; then next right; then left again. These paths are sometimes unclear so keep checking on your footpath app to remain on the route.
2. Continue straight across the next path crossroads and then branch right when the path forks. You will now be walking parallel with the B481.
3. When you meet the lane 'T' Junction; turn right. You should now have woodland on your right. (Red arrow.)
4. Follow this path through one path crossroads. At the next path junction, take the path which branches right. This will take you into Warburg Nature Reserve. Walk past the Wildlife Walk on your left and follow the central path as it bends sharply to the right through the reserve.
5. Stay on this path for about 2/3 mile and it will eventually lead into a lane. Take the lane called 'Magpies' on your right.
6. Stay on the lane until it changes into a footpath and continue to follow as it bends around to the left.
7. From then on, remain on the central path and it will take you back to the Recreation Ground.
