





## Nuffield: Short Route

DIFFICULTY RATING: LOW/MEDIUM: Gently undulating with varying terrain, mainly grass.

**START POINT**: Nuffield Church, RG9 55N. This route crosses some of the fairways of Huntercombe Golf Course. Please take great care, respect golfers who are playing and do not cross the fairway while a shot is being played. Please keep dogs on a lead.

## ROUTE

- 1. Start with the church on your right and take the footpath opposite the church which branches left across the golf course. This is the Ridgeway. Look out for the posts with yellow arrows to pass across the golf course from one side of each fairway to the other.
- 2. Just before the path meets the road, it will bend right. Follow as it bends (past the old Crown pub) and continue to follow across the golf course.
- 3. When you come to the road, cross over and continue to follow the footpath in front of you. You will come to a green gate in the hedge to your left. Go through this gate and continue on round the edge of the field.
- 4. When you reach Hayden Lane; turn right. (Red arrow)
- 5. At the next path junction, take the path immediately on your right.
- 6. Follow this path straight and you will meet Timbers Lane. Turn left for a few metres and then right, crossing over and heading down Nuffield Hill. This will lead you back to your starting point at Nuffield Church.
