



## Stoke Row: Short Route

**DIFFICULTY RATING:** LOW/MEDIUM: Varying terrain, generally through woodland.

START POINT: St John the Evangelist Church, Stoke Row, RG9 5RB. Park on School Lane.

## 1. Start between the church and the primary school and head down School Lane. When you reach the end of the lane, take the footpath which branches off across a field to the right. You may find friendly horses in this field. The crossing point is a style midway down the fence on the side of the field.

ROUTE

- 2. Turn right and then a sharp left and remain on the main path.
- 3. When you meet a crossroads of paths; turn left.
- 4. Follow the path through Ipsden Woods and this will eventually meet Busgrove Lane.
- 5. Turn left onto Busgrove Lane; walk a short distance and take your first right which is Neal's Lane.
- 6. Continue up Neal's Lane until you meet a crossroads. At the crossroads, turn left.
- 7. Follow this path, keeping left (do not head onto the Stoke Row Road, but stay left on the path when you see the road ahead). The path is slightly less obvious at this point but keep walking slightly to the left until you meet Busgrove Lane. Cross the lane and continue walking until you meet a 'T' junction of paths.
- 8. Turn right and this will take you back up School Lane to your starting point.
